

Awareness Month Ribbon Project

Group Size: Any

Time Commitment: 30 minutes to 1 hour

Items Needed: Year round

Awareness ribbons are distributed during Sexual Assault Awareness Month in April and Domestic Violence Awareness Month in October to symbolize awareness and support for victims and survivors.

The color designated for Sexual Assault Awareness Month is teal.



The color designated for Domestic Violence Awareness Month is purple



Items Needed

- Quarter inch satin or cotton ribbon
- Small safety pins (silver or gold)
- Small plastic bags
- Ruler or tape measure
- Scissors

Directions

- Length of each ribbon should be 4½ to 5 inches
- To make the front of ribbons – cross (loop) one of the ends over the other keeping the right side up on both
- Insert pin from the back through both pieces – then close pin to hold ribbon together
- Please bag them in groups of 25 or 50
