has been the victim of an attempted or completed rape in their lifetime.

College Students

- 13% of all students experience rape or sexual assault through physical force, violence, or incapacitation.
- 82% of all victims under 18 are female.
- 21% of TGQN (transgender, genderqueer, nonconforming) college students have been sexually assaulted.
- Male college-aged students (18-24) are 78% more likely than non-students of the same age to be a victim of rape or sexual assault.

Children

- **Every 9 minutes** a child is sexually assaulted in America.
- **93% of perpetrators** are known to the child and family.

LGBTQ+

- 40% of gay men and 47% of bisexual men have experienced sexual violence other than rape.
- 44% of lesbians and 61% of bisexual women and
- 26% of gay men and 37% of bisexual men have experienced rape, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner in their lifetime.

*Sexual Assault is the most underreported crime in the world.
