- Hope—with proven outcomes like reduced anxiety and stronger emotional well-being

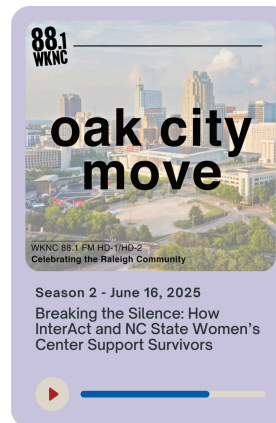
